Safer Sex

Safer sex is sometimes called Safe Sex.



This is about your health when you have sex.



Like

use a condom



• only get pregnant when you want to



- only have sex when it feels right for you.
 - Like
 - you feel safe
 - you feel the other person listens

to you

Condoms

you feel the other person respects you.



How to Stay Safe



Condoms stop sperm and egg meeting.

We call this a **barrier**.



They can lower the risk of you getting an STI.

Use condoms






• when the penis is stiff

It is ready for sex.

It is called an erection.



on a sex toy



in a vagina.



Use a condom 1 time only.



Put the used condom in the bin.



Use a **new** condom **every** time you have sex.



Sometimes condoms can

break

or

be used the wrong way.



This can mean that the sex is **not** safe.

How to stay safe -

Contraception

You can use other contraception to stop sperm and egg meeting.



Like

a pill



an implant

or



an IUD.




Use a condom too.

How to stay safe Feelings



Safer Sex also means

- you have sex when you are ready to have sex
- you have the sex you want
- you have sex you enjoyand
- the other person respects you.



It also means you have sex



- at a time you are happy with
- in a place you are happy about



that you feel good about after.



Sex that is not safe

Some people say

- unsafe sex
- unprotected sex.



This can mean you

do not use a condom




do not use other contraception




do not feel safe

and

 do not think the other person respects you.
